



School/pupil agreement

At Bright Futures School, we have some ground rules to help us all work well together and make sure we are considerate towards each other. These ground rules are:

- Talk to each other respectfully, not in a rude voice or with unkind words
- No negative talk about other pupils, including name-calling or 'put-downs'
- Be considerate and kind to each other
- Be helpful
- If we get upset, take a break to calm down
- Listen to each other's point of view
- To stay within adult boundaries and limits

If there is a disagreement or misunderstanding between pupils

- A member of staff will help pupils to understand each others' point of view

In the event of physical aggression or destruction of property, a) this will result in an exclusion from school (length of exclusion at the discretion of staff) and b) staff will decide whether to call the police.

Rewards

Pupils will get tokens from staff for things like being considerate and respectful, for thinking before speaking, for doing good work, for recovering from a setback, for being thoughtful, for sharing feelings when it feels difficult to do so. Pupils may not always be rewarded for the same thing – this will depend on their own particular challenges and difficulties.

Once a pupil has 30 tokens, they have £10 to spend on something educational that they can use at school.

Sanctions

Sanctions may be different depending on the pupil and are likely to include:

- Loss of screen time
- Loss of favoured activity (e.g. swimming, cycling, the farm, Mahdlo)

- Exclusion from school
- Any other sanction that staff decide is appropriate.
