



School/student agreement

At Bright Futures School, we have some ground rules to help us all work well together and make sure we are considerate towards each other. These ground rules are:

- Talk to each other respectfully, not in a rude voice or with unkind words
- No negative talk about other pupils, including name-calling or 'put-downs'
- Be considerate and kind to each other
- Be helpful
- If we get upset, take a break to calm down
- Listen to each other's point of view
- To stay within adult boundaries and limits

If there is a disagreement or misunderstanding between students

- A member of staff will help students to understand each others' point of view. If there is still a disagreement then the adult's decision is final.

Rewards

Students will get tokens from staff for things like being considerate and respectful, for thinking before speaking, for doing good work, for recovering from a setback, for being thoughtful, for sharing feelings when it feels difficult to do so. Students may not always be rewarded for the same thing – this will depend on their own particular challenges and difficulties.

Once a student has 30 tokens, they have £10 to spend on something educational that they can use at school.

Natural consequences

We will always try firstly to support a student to self-regulate and then try collaborative problem-solving with them. If this is not successful, we may have to apply a natural consequence.

These may include (but are not restricted to):

- Loss of screen time
- Loss of activity
- Being isolated from others
- Exclusion from school
- Any other consequence that staff decide is appropriate.

In the event of physical aggression or destruction of property, a) this may result in an exclusion from school (length of exclusion at the discretion of staff) and b) staff will decide whether to call the police.
