

School/student agreement

At Bright Futures School, we have some ground rules to help us all work well together and make sure we are considerate towards each other. These ground rules are:

- Talk to each other respectfully, not in a rude voice or with unkind words
- No negative talk about other pupils, including name-calling or 'put-downs'
- Be considerate and kind to each other
- Be helpful
- If we get upset, take a break to calm down
- Listen to each other's point of view
- To stay within adult boundaries and limits

If there is a disagreement or misunderstanding between students

• A member of staff will help students to understand each other's point of view. If there is still a disagreement then the adult's decision is final.

In the event of physical aggression or destruction of property, a) this may result in an exclusion from school (length of exclusion at the discretion of staff) and b) staff will decide whether to call the police.

Natural consequences

We will always try firstly to support a student to self-regulate (e.g., by giving some thinking time in the sensory room). We may also try collaborative-problem solving. If neither of these is successful, we may have to apply a natural consequence.

These may to include (but are not restricted to):

- Loss of screen time
- Loss of activity
- Exclusion from school
- Any other consequence that staff decide is appropriate.
