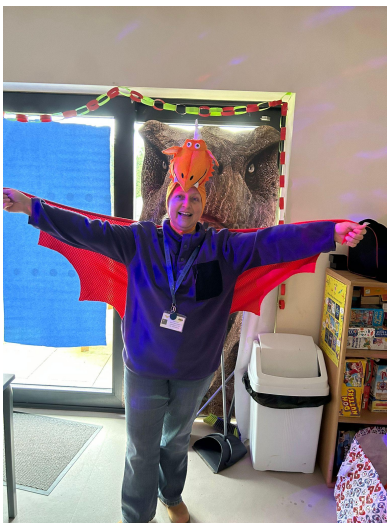
**World Book Day - This year our theme was Dinosaurs and Dragons. We introduced our new Buddy Book Scheme and each of the Upper School Students partnered with**
